Evaluation Process to measure Attainment of POs, PSOs and COs

Evaluation of Programme Outcomes (POs) Attainment

It measures the performance of students conveying intent of study programme to achieve expected objective that graduate students must have acquired at the time of completion of their programme. Therefore at the end of every programme, evaluation of attainment of POs is carried out from the COs and PSOs attainment of all subjects.

Evaluation of Attainment of Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs)

Overall attainment of PSOs of the programme offered is calculated on the basis of PSOs at department level. Each department evaluate attainment of PSOs on the basis of "Level of Attainment" of all related COs and the overall performance of students in GD, seminars, class tests, projects, quizzes, assignments, co-curricular activities, semester end common test, students' feedback on teaching, learning & evaluation and students satisfaction survey.

Evaluation of Attainment of Course Outcomes (COs)

Attainments of COs are calculated by using university examination results. Attainment levels are finalized in departmental meeting at college level and conveyed to IQAC through Examination Committee.

1. Attainment of COs is considered on the performance of students in every semester examination conducted by the university.
2. Programme and course wise result analysis report is prepared after the declaration of university results by every department.



3. Following method is carried out to evaluate attainment level for all COs for each course; as per defined criteria.

Attainment levels:

1. Attainment level 1: 1-25% students scored ≥ 40 percent marks in University examination.
(Lowest level is considered as attainment level 1)
2. Attainment level 2: 26-50% students scored ≥ 40 percent marks in University examination.
(Here attainment level is considered as 2)
3. Attainment level 3: 51-75% students scored ≥ 40 percent marks in University examination.
(Here attainment level is considered as 3)
4. Attainment level 4: 76-100% students scored ≥ 40 percent marks in University examination.
(Highest level is considered as attainment level 4)
