## Automation of News Paper Clipping Service using WINISIS : a complete solution

#### Abstract:

News Paper Clipping Service including cutting, pasting and storing of clippings which was time consuming, requires more funds, more space, manpower, time to search and also was not that much durable. Researcher has used two methods: first includes design of database to access and search the bibliographic details about newspaper clipping and second includes the storage of clipping in the digital form. The database with bibliographical details also provides link for the actual stored news and online link to the news also. The search and link option provides exact and precise access in fraction of seconds to the clips in various formats.

Today libraries are facing the problems of funds and manpower and besides have to walk with the present scenario of IT based library services. Because of information explosion, libraries have been growing in size as well as complexity in terms of library management and library services. With this, libraries also require flexibility in library software as per local needs and requirements. Accordingly, libraries require a high degree of efficiency, which can be possible by automation of Library services.

All the library services can be automated using Computer, Multimedia and software. In the

present study WINISIS (Window Based Integrated Set of Information System) introduced by UNESCO is used by the researcher to automate the News Paper Clipping Service.

#### Automation:

The word "Automation" is derived from the Greek word "Automose" meaning something which has the power of spontaneous motion of self movement.

Automation or Computerization means application of computer hardware and software in day-to-day and repetitive jobs, which helps to save laborious work, time and money. It also helps to speed up the operations and increase all-round productivity with quality and quantity.

#### WINISIS:

CDS/ISIS for Windows is an information retrieval package developed by UNESCO (the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization) which runs under Microsoft Windows.

#### Features of WINISIS:

CDS/ISIS is a generalized Information Storage Retrieval system. It is intended to be used for structured non-numerical databases containing mainly texts.

- It is specialized in handling variable-length information.
- It may manage stand-alone as well as local network database systems.
- Unlike Dbase or MS-Access, CDS/ISIS is not a relational database system, although it provides some relational facilities.
- CDS/ISIS may be expanded by advanced users (programmers) for adding new services and tools.
- A wide variety of solutions for Internet publishing of data are already available.

For the purpose of automation of News Paper Clipping Service special database is designed using four main components of WINISIS i.e. Field Definition Table, Data Entry Worksheet, Print Format and Field Select Table.

**1. Field Definition Table:** It provides details about the various fields defined to create the databases.

**2. Data Entry Worksheet:** It shows the structure of data to be entered in the worksheet.

**3. Print Format:** It is also called as display format. It is used to display the contents of database in various formats.

**4. Field Selection Table:** It is used to define the searchable fields and to create the term dictionary of useful or retrievable keywords

#### News Paper Clipping Service:

The researcher has tried to develop the automated newspaper-clipping module with the help of WINISIS. Now a day to store the important newspaper clippings is going to be a critical job. The traditional service requires cutting, pasting and storing of clippings which was time consuming, requires more funds, more space, manpower, time to search and also was not that much durable.

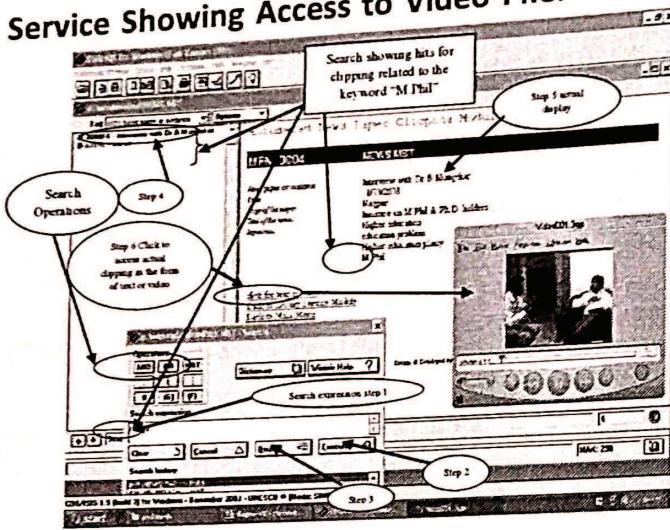

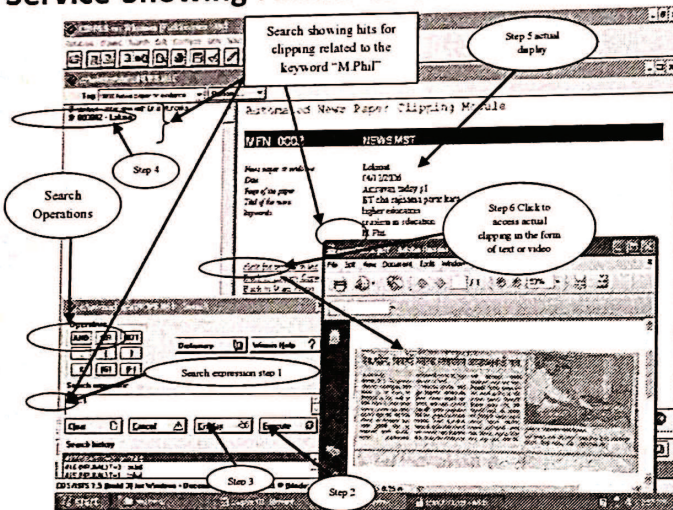
The database for News Paper Clipping

The database window no.1 and 2 show systematic approach to the search of newspaper clipping. Both the windows show the search conducted for the keyword "M.Phil.". The search shows two news related to the keyword, out of that first news is stored with video clip in the "3gp" file format and the second news is scanned news paper clip in "pdf" format. The use of "click for text or video" option in the first window provides access to video file and in second window to the text file. The Online Link option provides direct access to the related online newspaper.

#### Conclusion :

- The database module designed for the clippings facilitates access and search with

various options.

- It is easy to Design, Install, Use, Update, Backup and Data Entry.
- It reduces the time of the user and provides address of various clips related to one keyword at a time.

- The database module reduces the problem of space and durability in storage of clipping.

- The module facilitates reproduction of copies in various forms and maintains overall quality in the service.
