Entrepreneurship Development Cell had arranged One week training workshop on "Bamboo Patti Rangkam v Rakhi Manufacturing" from 08-08-2019 to 14-08-2019. This training workshop was organized as a part of "Earn While Learn" scheme. Rakhi festival is celebrated throughout India. There is a good demand of rakhi made by handmade paper, colorful thin strips of bamboo, called bamboo patti and other accessories like ornamental beads & laces. Keeping this in mind the workshop was arranged. In the first part of training, the trainers from ,taught the students about how to color the bamboo strips by using natural colors. In the second part the students learned to cut the bamboo strips and then made the rakhi using the raw materials. About 05 students participated in the workshop and made beautiful rakhis. We tried to sell these rakhi. Many of our staff purchased these rakhi. Sampurna Bamboo Kendra provided all the technical assistance and the raw material. Next year we will try to make these rakhi in advance well prior to the festival 'Raksha Bandhan', and try to sell the produce on large scale so that the students will get more profit. Coordinator of ED Cell Mr. S.L. Kottewar & all the members of cell, from commerce department with his colleagues worked for the success of the program.
