Total 44 students were enrolled for the test and 44 students passed in this test. Test paper was set and evaluated by all the teachers of commerce faculty. After evaluation students were categorized under four heads

Test paper was set & evaluated by members of internal exam committee of science faculty. Exam contain 50 multiple choice question & each question contain 1 marks. After evaluation, students were categorized under three categories :






