





3. This Letter of Intent shall become effective as of the date of signatures of both parties. It may be amended by the written consent of the parties.
4. This Letter of Intent should be reviewed every five years to evaluate the progress and the quality of the mutual cooperation. It may be extended for additional five year periods upon the written consent of both parties. If the Letter of Intent is not renewed by mutual consent, then it will conclude at the end of the specified time period, or after activities in progress have concluded.
5. This Letter of Intent may be terminated by either party with a minimum of 120 days written notice. Activities in progress at the time of termination shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.
6. Both institutions subscribe to a policy of equal opportunity and will not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, marital status, parental status, disability, or veteran status.



CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

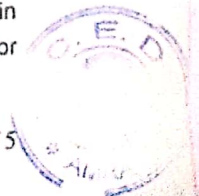

The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU

shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2

SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their learning sense and knowledge.
- 2.2 Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in developing experimental skills at the Laboratories and classrooms of second party and suitably customize the informal part of curriculum and research segments so that the students fit into the skill oriented science attitude meaningfully.
- 2.3 For association to build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The First Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites / intellectual assistance to the research projects for the hands-on experimental experience to the students enrolled / registered / suggested for the purpose.
- 2.4 Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint experimental activities in the fields of Science.
- 2.5 Guest talks and subsequent discussions may be organized by First / Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver skills to the students of the Second Party on the current trends and in house requirements.
- 2.6 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the programs on the terms specified herein
- 2.7 There is no financial commitment on the part of the Name of institution, the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt through proper process, if required.
- 2.8 Very Purpose of this MoU acts for the following specific issues / transformations:
 - To interact formally with the students
 - To develop and maintain scientific temperament
 - To organize guest lecturers from in house expertise
 - To organize tours / study visits
 - To organize lectures to create and maintain research atmosphere
 - To organize lectures to develop students' interest in the sciences
 - To interact with the research students
 - To resolve queries of research scholars
 - To provide the facilities at minimal rates
 - To provide an assistance to write research documents
 - To guide to process the research proposals
 - To share available learning resources
 - To organize Local / State / National / International events
 - To organize presentations of the research scholars on the topics of their studie
- 2.9 Parties 1 & 2 both will provide all the relevant facilities to the relevant stakeholders under this MoU depending upon availability. Providing facilities will not termed to the financial burdens to any of the parties.

CLAUSE 3

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4

VALIDITY

- 4.1 Primarily this MoU is effective for five years from the date of its establishment.
- 4.2 This MoU /Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms i.e. till breach of draft or till any point related to validation of the clauses.
- 4.3 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing / through electronic dialogue. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
- 5.2 Both the parties will have to share necessary reports / documents regarding the programs conducted through either of the parties within a stipulated time period.
- 5.3 Extreme level emergencies like pandemic situations / lockdown / etc be tackled through the discussion

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Amravati.
